Community Integration Outcome Report 2010

Our day programs continue to be available to individuals who choose an alternative to work. Previously these services were only available to individuals in the ICF/MR level of care. These programs have expanded now to include Day Habilitation as an option under the Home and Community Based Waiver program and the Habilitation Program

Our Day Habilitation Programs have expanded in Elma, Mason City and Cedar Falls and we have started 2 new programs in New Hampton and Cedar Falls over the last year. Eighty three individuals choose Day Habilitation Services as an alternative to work. Twenty individuals have chosen part time Work and part time Day Habilitation Services. With Day Habilitation offered in our workshop areas, this gives individuals the availability to choose the half-day option. We continue to see this program area expand and grow in all of our service areas.

We believe that we are able to be more efficient with the services that we provide to individuals when we are able to share staff between our day programs and our residential areas. This allows for cross training and more consistency for the individuals served. The hours shared for 2010 were 44. We believe that as funding becomes tighter for vocational programs, more individuals will transition into community integration programs.

Satisfaction continues to be high at 99.8% for Community Integration.
