Residential Services Community Housing

Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID) was developed for children and adults who need an ongoing, high-level of staff support. Medical supports are provided. Social skills and daily living skills are taught in a homelike environment. This service is provided 24-hours a day, 7-days a week.



ICF/IID Day Services Community Integration

ICF/IID Day Services support individuals in developing or maintaining life skills or skills for community integration. This service is provided in a structured setting or in the community.

Operating hours: Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m.- 3:30 p.m.

Residential Services Community Housing

Residential Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (RCF/IID) provides a structured environment for adults, who require minimal support and supervision in completing activities of daily living. Nursing and other professional services are provided based on the individual needs of the consumer. Supported Community Living (SCL) is a service component for individuals living in our RCF/IID programs. This service is provided 24-hours a day, 7-days a week.



Residential Services Supported Living

Supported Community Living (SCL) and Home Based Habilitation services are provided according to the individualized needs as identified in the Individual Program Plan. The basic components of the services include, but are not limited to, personal and home skills training, individual advocacy services, and community integration skills. These services are available from 1-hour a week up to 24-hours a day, 7-days a week.
